



#### Creation a recurring theme in the Bible

• "By the word of the Lord were the heavens made; and all the host of them by the breath of His mouth." "For He spake, and it was;" "He commanded, and it stood fast." Psalm 33:6, 9. He "laid the foundations of the earth, that it should not be removed forever." Psalm 104:5. (Opening sentences in 'The Creation' PP 44)



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## Six *literal* days

Gen 1:5 - ...And the evening and the morning were

the first day.

8 – second day

- 13 third day
- 19- fourth day
- 23 fifth day
- 31 Then God saw everything that He had made, and indeed *it was* very good. So the evening and the morning were the sixth day

#### The culmination of creation – The Sabbath

 Thus the heavens and the earth, and all the host of them, were finished. And on the seventh day God ended His work which He had done, and He rested on the seventh day from all His work which He had done. Then God blessed the seventh day and sanctified it, because in it He rested from all His work which God had created and made. Gen 2: 2,3



#### Creation in Genesis commemorates the Sabbath



God reminds us of creation in the Sabbath commandment Ex: 20:8-11

#### Ex 20: 8-11

Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: But the seventh day is the sabbath of the LORD thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates: For in six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day:



#### The literal week – PP 111

 Like the Sabbath, the week originated at creation, and it has been preserved and brought down to us through Bible history. God Himself measured off the first week as a sample for successive weeks to the close of time. Like every other, it consisted of seven literal days. Six days were employed in the work of creation; upon the seventh, God rested, and He then blessed this day and set it apart as a day of rest for man. (Opening sentence in *The literal week* PP 111)

## Genesis commemorates salvation (The first promise)

 And I will put enmity Between you and the woman, And between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, And you shall bruise His heel." Gen 3:15



### The Genesis creation

- culminates in the Sabbath -a pillar in our faith
- It provides us with an explanation of our origin - "Let us make man in our image"
- Gen 3 introduces salvation the first promise

Seventh-Day Adventists have *never* moved from this position of a *literal* 6 day creation

### Origin views

- Atheistic Evolution (Darwinian evolution)
- Special Creation (as described and interpreted literally in Genesis)
- Theistic evolution a blend between the first two - there is quite a continuum from God just setting things in motion at one end to God performing miracles along the evolutionary pathway

## Be careful - know what you believe

- What I faced almost 30 years ago at an overseas SDA institution
- I was not prepared for what was presented
- Millions of years regularly taught, ridiculing a young earth, laughing at being invited to an international field trip/conference looking at evidence for creation
- What you believe can have a huge influence on others with eternal consequences

## Know before you go!

 You can reach young people with open hearts and open minds

 When someone becomes established as a scientist after undergraduate and postgraduate training and indoctrinated in evolutionary theory - it can be extremely difficult to reach their hearts, the bias is just so extreme

## Theistic evolution Hit head-on by EG White

 But the assumption that the events of the first week required thousands upon thousands of years, strikes directly at the foundation of the fourth commandment. It represents the Creator as commanding men to observe the week of literal days in commemoration of vast, indefinite periods. This is unlike His method of dealing with His creatures. It makes indefinite and obscure that which He has made very plain. It is infidelity in its most insidious and hence most dangerous form; its real character is so disguised that it is held and taught by many who profess to believe the Bible. PP 111 – "The Literal Week"

Theistic evolution doesn't work. Trying to mix creation with evolution makes no sense. It requires death of organisms during and extended 'creation process' with God proclaiming 'It was good...' at each step.

It makes no logical sense and is a theological disconnect.

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- Such teaching lowers the great work of the Creator to the level of man's narrow, earthly conceptions. Men are so intent upon excluding God from the sovereignty of the universe that they degrade man and defraud him of the dignity of his origin. He who set the starry worlds on high and tinted with delicate skill the flowers of the field, who filled the earth and the heavens with the wonders of His power, when He came to crown His glorious work, to place one in the midst to stand as ruler of the fair earth, did not fail to create a being worthy of the hand that gave him life.

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- The genealogy of our race, as given by inspiration, traces back its origin, not to a line of developing germs, mollusks, and quadrupeds, but to the great Creator. Though formed from the dust, Adam was "the son of God."

• 1844 movement - - And the angel which I saw stand upon the sea and upon the earth lifted up his hand to heaven, And sware by him that liveth for ever and ever, who created heaven, and the things that therein are, and the earth, and the things that therein are, and the sea, and the things which are therein, that there should be time no longer. Rev 10: 5-6

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- **Proclamation of 3 Angels messages** -- And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people, Saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters. Rev 14: 6,7 (A quote from the 4<sup>th</sup> commandment)
