




Diagram of Leviticus

Scapegoat

- Purpose: Elimination rite. To remove sin from the camp, leave the camp clean.

Scapegoat

- Deuteronomy 19:15-20: Law of the malicious witness is an analog for what should happen to Satan after the great controversy is settled.

Cleansing in the Heart

- “Afflict your souls” (Leviticus 16:29, 31; 23:27, 29, 32).
- Set aside those things that could lead to pride and self sufficiency, such as jewelry (Exodus 33:5, 6; Isaiah 3:13-23).


Cleansing in the Heart






