Daniel 9:2 I, Daniel, understood by the books the number of the years specified by the word of the Lord through Jeremiah the prophet, that He would accomplish seventy years in the desolations of Jerusalem.

- **Jeremiah 25:1-11** “this whole land shall be a desolation and an astonishment, and these nations shall serve the king of Babylon seventy years.”
- **Jeremiah 29:10-14** “thus says the Lord: After seventy years are completed at Babylon, I will visit you and perform My good word toward you, and cause you to return to this place.”

Daniel 9:3-19 “O Lord, hear! O Lord, forgive! O Lord, listen and act! *Do not delay* for Your own sake, my God, for Your city and Your people are called by Your name.”

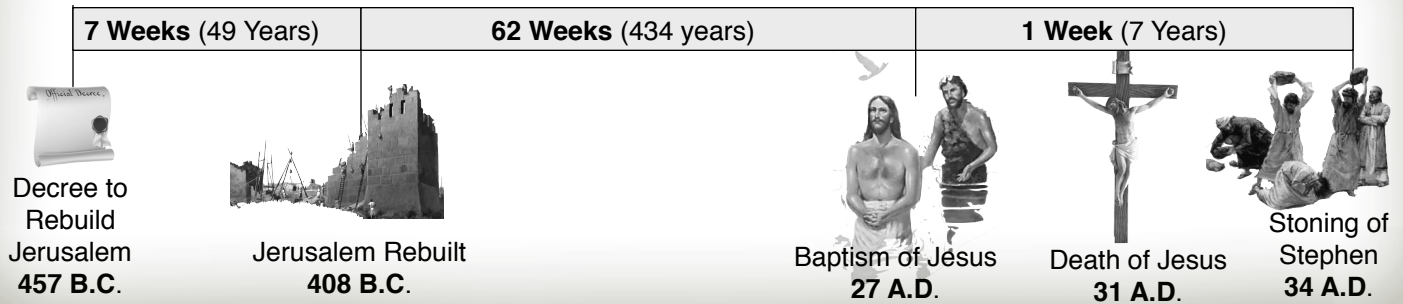
“Understand the Vision”

- The word “_____” that we find in Daniel 8 and 9 actually comes from two different Hebrew words: “_____” and “_____.”
- *Hazon* refers to the _____ vision while *Mareh* refers only to a _____ of the vision.

Daniel 9:21-23 “While I was speaking in prayer, the man Gabriel, whom I had seen in the vision [hazon] at the beginning, being caused to fly swiftly, reached me about the time of the evening offering. And he informed me, and talked with me, and said, “O Daniel, I have now come forth to give you skill to understand. 23 At the beginning of your supplications the command went out, and I have come to tell you, for you are greatly beloved; therefore consider the matter, and understand the vision [mareh]”

- **Daniel 8:1, 2** In the third year of the reign of King Belshazzar a vision [hazon] appeared to me--to me, Daniel--after the one that appeared to me the first time. 2 I saw in the vision [hazon], and it so happened while I was looking, that I was in Shushan, the citadel, which is in the province of Elam; and I saw in the vision [hazon] that I was by the River Ulai.
- **Daniel 8:26, 27** “And the vision [mareh] of the evenings and mornings which was told is true; Therefore seal up the vision [hazon], for it refers to many days in the future.” 27 And I, Daniel, fainted and was sick for days; afterward I arose and went about the king's business. I was astonished by the vision [mareh], but no one understood it.”

- The answer to the time prophecy of Daniel 8 (“2300 days”) is the time prophecy of Daniel 9 (“70 weeks”).

Daniel 9:24 "Seventy weeks are determined for your people and for your holy city, to finish the transgression, to make an end of sins, to make reconciliation for iniquity, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal up vision and prophecy, and to anoint the Most Holy.

- "seal up vision and prophecy" **Luke 4:18-21**
- "anoint the Most Holy" **Matthew 3:16; Acts 10:38**

Daniel 9:25 "Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the command to restore and build Jerusalem until Messiah the Prince, there shall be seven weeks and sixty-two weeks; The street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublesome times.

- "The command to restore and rebuild Jerusalem" **Ezra 7:1-26**
- "The street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublesome times." **Nehemiah 4:7-18**

Daniel 9:26, 27 And after the sixty-two weeks Messiah shall be cut off, but not for Himself... he shall confirm a covenant with many for one week; But in the middle of the week He shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering.

- "Messiah shall be cut off, but not for Himself" **Isaiah 53:4-6; 2 Corinthians 5:21**
- "in the middle of the week He shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering" **John 1:29; 1 Corinthians 5:7**

Daniel 9:26, 27 And the people of the prince who is to come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary. The end of it shall be with a flood, And till the end of the war desolations are determined... And on the wing of abominations shall be one who makes desolate, even until the consummation, which is determined, is poured out on the desolate."

- "the people of the prince who is to come" (Rome) **Daniel 8:23-25; 2 Thessalonians 2:3-7**
- "shall destroy the city and the sanctuary" **Matthew 24:1, 2**
- "abominations shall be one who makes desolate" **Matthew 24:15, 16**
