# 1 Jn 2:15

- Love not the world, neither the things in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.



# Point 1

- Love not the world
- Literal reading
  - 2Cr 4:18 While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen [are] eternal.
  - 2Cr 5:1 For we know that if our earthly house of this tabernacle were dissolved, we have a building of God, an house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens.
  - Col 3:1-2 If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God. Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth.

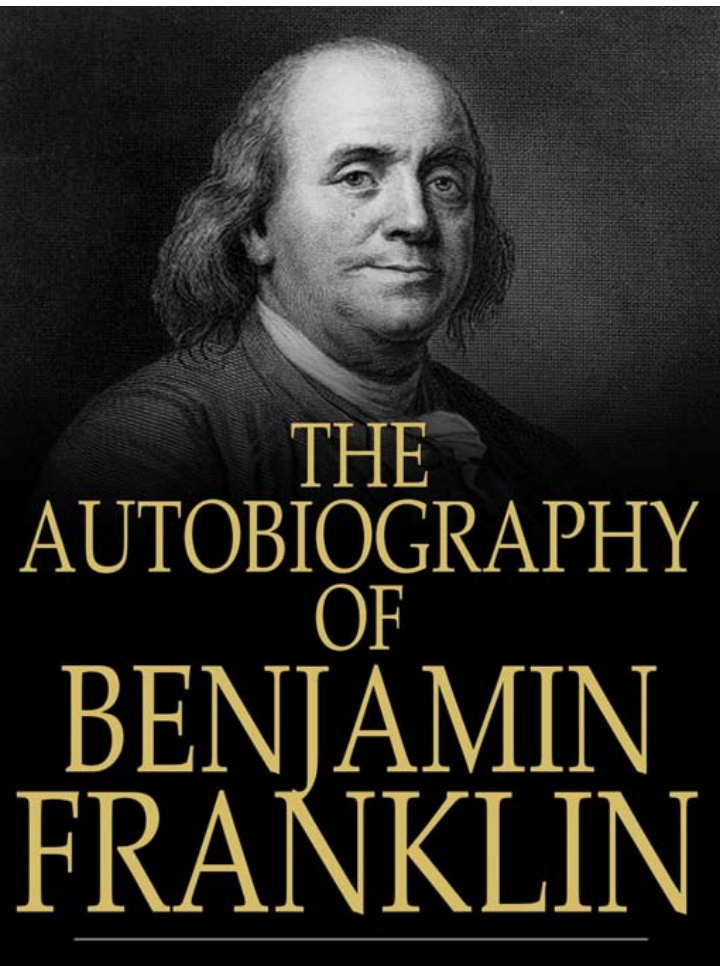

# SC 35
