 As thou hast given him power over all flesh, that he should give eternal life to as many as thou hast given him.

 And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent

 I have glorified thee on the earth: I have finished the work which thou gavest me to do

 And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was

 I have manifested thy name unto the men which thou gavest me out of the world: thine they were, and thou gavest them me; and they have kept thy word

Now they have known that all things
 whatsoever thou hast given me are of thee.
 For I have given unto them the words which
 thou gavest me; and they have received
 [them], and have known surely that I came
 out from thee, and they have believed that
 thou didst send me

Vs 9-10

 I pray for them: I pray not for the world, but for them which thou hast given me; for they are thine. And all mine are thine, and thine are mine; and I am glorified in them

Vs 11-13a

 And now I am no more in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to thee. Holy Father, keep through thine own name those whom thou hast given me, that they may be one, as we are. While I was with them in the world, I kept them in thy name: those that thou gavest me I have kept, and none of them is lost, but the son of perdition; that the scripture might be fulfilled. And now come I to thee

 I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil.

Vs 25-26

 O righteous Father, the world hath not known thee: but I have known thee, and these have known that thou hast sent me. And I have declared unto them thy name, and will declare it: that the love wherewith thou hast loved me may be in them, and I in them.

 As trials thicken around us, both separation and unity will be seen in our ranks. Some...will in times of real peril make it manifest that they have not built upon the solid rock...But, on the other hand, when the storm of persecution really breaks upon us, the true sheep will hear the true Shepherd's voice. Self-denying efforts will be put forth to save the lost, and many who have strayed from the fold will come back...

 The people of God will draw together and present to the enemy a united front...strife for supremacy will cease; there will be no disputing as to who shall be accounted greatest...Thus will be answered the prayer of Christ, uttered just before His humiliation and death: "That they all may be one; as Thou, Father, art in Me, and I in Thee, that they also may be one in Us: that the world may believe that Thou hast sent Me."

 The love of Christ, the love of our brethren, will testify to the world that we have been with Jesus and learned of Him. Then will the message of the third angel swell to a loud cry, and the whole earth will be lightened with the glory of the Lord.
