Daniel 7:8-10 I was considering the horns, and there was another horn, a little one, coming up among them, before whom three of the first horns were plucked out by the roots. And there, in this horn, were eyes like the eyes of a man, and a mouth speaking pompous words. "I watched till thrones were put in place, and the Ancient of Days was seated... The court was seated, and the books were opened. 865

Daniel 7:13, 14 "I was watching in the night visions, and behold, One like the Son of Man, coming with the clouds of heaven! He came to the Ancient of Days, and they brought Him near before Him. Then to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed. 865

Daniel 7:25-27 He shall speak pompous words against the Most High, shall persecute the saints of the Most High, and shall intend to change times and law. Then the saints shall be given into his hand for a time and times and half a time. 'But the court shall be seated, and they shall take away his dominion, to consume and destroy it forever. Then the kingdom and dominion, and the greatness of the kingdoms under the whole heaven, shall be given to the people, the saints of the Most High. His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and all dominions shall serve and obey Him.' 865

Revelation 22:11,12 "He who is unjust, let him be unjust still; he who is filthy, let him be filthy still; he who is righteous, let him be righteous still; he who is holy, let him be holy still. And behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward is with Me, to give to every one according to his work." 1190

The Sanctuary: Entire Plan of Salvation in Jesus

- Lamb raised in the camp yet without blemish
- Transference of guilt from sinner to sacrifice
- Substitutionary death of the sacrificial lamb
- Priest's work: Daily intercession in the Holy Place
- High priest's work: Atonement in Most Holy Place

Daniel 2
















- ✓ Gives a general overview of human history.
- ✓ There is no mention of Daniel being worried at all.

Daniel 7

- ✓ The "little horn" (antichrist power) and the duration of his reign for 1260 years is revealed.
- ✓ A heavenly judgment before the return of Christ is also revealed.
- ✓ Daniel is "greatly troubled."

Daniel 8

- ✓ The focus once again is on the "little horn" and his blasphemous, violent activities.
- ✓ Daniel is told the judgment in heaven will begin at the end of 2300 years.
- ✓ No starting point for the 2300 years is given and the vision stalls... Christ's kingdom isn't mentioned!
- ✓ Daniel "fainted and was sick." He was "astonished by the vision, but *no one understood it.*"
