SESSION #4 PERSONAL REFLECTIONS FOR GROWING IN THE HOLY SPIRIT

We have the solid promise that the Holy Spirit is the answer for everything we need to reach the world (Acts 1:8). What does that really mean? What will it look like when the Holy Spirit is really working through God's people? How can we have that power in our lives?

The answers to those questions can be found in Acts 2 and the rest of the Bible. There we can find at least ten areas in which the Holy Spirit works in us. We need the Holy Spirit both to prepare us for Jesus' coming and to empower us to share the gospel with the world. Search the scriptures to know the Holy Spirit personally presented by the scripture of this great gift. Reflect on your need here

1. Conviction. "Omnipresence of the Spirit" John 16:7-11; 14:16-18; Psalm 139:7-10 What is God convicting me to change in my life? Is there something He wants me to do or say?

2. Conversion. "Born of the Spirit" John 3; John 7:37-39 Am I a new person in Christ today, walking in the joy of forgiveness and in the transforming power of Christ living in me?

3. Relationship with God. "Sword of the Spirit" John 15, Ezekiel 37:1-10; Ephesians 6:17 Am I spending meaningful time with God every day in Bible study? Is His word re-creating me?

4. Christian Character. "Fruit of the Spirit" Galatians 5:22-23 Am I becoming more and more like Jesus, demonstrating the fruit of the Spirit in my relationships with my family, my neighbors, and my co-workers? Am I walking in victory?

5. Prayer. "Breath of the Spirit" Romans 8:26-27 Am I spending significant time praying for myself, my family, my church, and the lost? Do I pray with faith expecting miracles from God?

6. Good Works. "Gifts of the Spirit" Luke 4:18-19; 1 Corinthians 12; Romans 12 Am I using my gifts to help the sick, the poor, the sorrowful, and those in bondage to habits or evil spirits?

7. Spoken Witness. "Tongues of the Spirit" Acts 2; Acts 4:31; Matthew 10:18-20; Luke 11:5-13 Am I telling others the gospel with earnest love and boldness? Am I frequently telling my testimony? Am I sharing with those of other languages?

8. Community of Believers. "Body of the Spirit" 1 Corinthians 12:4-7; Ephesians 2:13-22; 4:1-6 Am I loving towards the Christians in my church, forgiving them, encouraging them, and kindly rebuking them when they are wrong?

9. Worship. "Temple of the Spirit" John 4:23-24; 1 Peter 2:5-10; Ephesians 5:18-20 Am I praising God in the midst of trials? Do I regularly worship God with my words, songs, and attitude?

10. Multiplication. "Latter Rain of the Spirit" Zechariah 10:1; Hosea 6:3; Joel 2:23 Am I praying daily for the final outpouring of the Holy Spirit? Am I leading a small group or helping an individual to receive the Holy Spirit day by day?
