Lettuce - many good varieties. We recently "discovered" Summer Crisp lettuces and have been very impressed with Muir, Nevada, and Magenta. Try pelleted seeds for ease of sowing (for full-size heads). Salanova lettuces are used for "cut and come again" baby lettuce

Melons - Sarah's Choice*

Okra - Clemson Spineless*, Burgundy

Onions (full size) - we have been challenged by onions. Intermediate types generally do best. We have had the best success with white ones (like Sierra Blanca and Mt. Whitney); (bunching) - Parade

Peas - this has also been a challenging one for us in our climate. We don't do much with them. Sugar Snaps seem to be the most profitable option.

Peppers - We have had our best success with sweet specialty peppers like Carmen* and Oranos*. We always do a few hot peppers (Jalapenos, Cayennes, and Poblanos). We are trying greenhouse varieties of Bell peppers this year.

Potatoes - Yukon Gold*, Kennebecs, and Red Pontiac

Radishes - Pink Beauty, D'Avignon, (Red Meat, Shunkyo Semi-long, Nero Tondo - winter)

Spinach - Space, Corvair

Summer Squash - Zephyr*, Success, Dunja

Winter Squash - Butternut and Delicata*

Tomatoes - Cherokee Purple, Moskvich*, Cosmonaut Volkov*, Sun Gold*, Big Beef, Celebrity, Tomimaru Muchoo, Pink Beauty, (Bradley* - local favorite), Golden Sweet. We grow many other varieties, but these have done the best for us so far. Turnips - Hakurei*, (Purple Top White Globe - winter) Watermelons - Crimson Sweet*, Ali Baba, Orangeglo
