

Alpha to Omega





The important thing to remember is that the closing events are simply the full and final display of the principles and methods that have gone before—on both sides, good and evil.

Just as Satan will have nothing new, so we must be careful to not bring in any new methods and principles of our own as we try to finish the work that Jesus began and then entrusted into our hands. Remember?

But it's even more than that!



One quick question to think about here:

If this united work is *the* true interpretation of the gospel, what does that make all other interpretations?

These are Satan's accusations against God and His government. We saw them in the presentation about Lucifer, and again in the one on Christ. That's when we started crossing accusations off the list—when we saw that Jesus had proven Satan wrong on most of them.

Most. But not all. There are still three there. Why? And what is God going to do about them?

We don't have time to look at all the details of these three accusations, but I can tell you that they are fascinating, especially number seven. And there is something special about these three; each one is intricately connected with the fate of sinful human beings. In fact, the task of proving them false was something that Jesus could not accomplish by Himself. To do so requires evidence from another source....








Now, it seems to me that Adventists have a bit of a blind spot when it comes to spiritualism. We often think of it only in terms of seances and the supposed spirits of the dead.

That's a part of it, to be sure, but there's more. Ellen White wrote much about the "spirits of the dead" aspect, of course, but when she turns her attention to the more philosophical side of the topic, the "no death" issue is almost lost sight of in all the bad stuff that comes from it.

Perhaps the most basic thing to remember about Satan's end time deceptions is that they are all counterfeits. Of course, the first thing that comes to mind here is probably this:

This isn't a new thought, of course. It's been in Great Controversy all along, and probably most of us are familiar with it already. But there's more to this picture than we usually notice.

What do you suppose "primitive godliness" looks like? Yeah, it's medical missionary work.

So what would a counterfeit look like? Yeah, it'll look like medical missionary work.

How do I know that? I kept reading.



This idea of the devil's counterfeit just keeps showing up. It's not a new thought, but what worries me is that we have been so focused on counterfeit doctrine—Sunday instead of Sabbath, conscious dead instead of sleeping dead—that we might easily overlook the devil's counterfeit of the real work Christ's people will be doing.


It's certainly true that "statements"—what we might call "doctrine" will be involved, but the emphasis is on "marvelous works" and "miracles." Why?



In other words, Satan is doing exactly what he has to do to look like Jesus....



Now, despite the devil's efforts to make his work look like God's work, there will be differences. Some of these won't easily be visible—because Satan is a liar and he doesn't want people to understand what's really going on.





OK, let's go back to Ellen White's description of the alpha and notice some details.




This is the story of the wise man and the foolish man. One built on the rock, the other on the sand, "and the rain came a'tumblin' down."

Two houses. But one storm. The same storm.

Christ never said anything about the houses being different from each other. For all we know, they looked identical. But there was a difference. The foundation.

The wise man's house was not shielded from the storm. It endured the storm because it was built on the rock.




But what is that storm and tempest? And when is this all going to happen?

We call it the "little time of trouble." And though I'm no prophet, it's easy to believe that it could be coming soon. The financial, political, medical, and social systems of our world are close to failing. Who knows what might make it all collapse?

And this is the point: When that collapse comes, there will be two teams of "medical missionaries." One team will be doing a work "identical" to the work of Christ, while the other team will be doing a work that "looks" identical to the work of Christ.

Both groups will be "helping people." Why? Because, given world conditions at that time, that's the only thing that is going to have any impact on the world.


God's people will be ministering to the people—both for their physical health and their spiritual health. They'll be doing the same thing Jesus did when He was here.

The foundation!




The foundation is the difference.

And when food, or money, or clothing, or whatever starts to run low, the selfish heart is going to stop giving. Like Lucifer in the beginning, sin has turned all who have chosen it into liars and murderers. Not trusting God's love and wisdom to care for them, they have taken upon themselves the responsibility of caring for themselves.

And supplies are low. The selfish heart refuses to give or serve anymore. The structure of counterfeit service is swept away.

But Christians, those who have built on the foundation of Christ, what about them? They are in the middle of the same storm. How could it be any different?

It's different because "Christ our righteousness" is the experience of faith, and they've learned the lesson from the story of Christ feeding the 5,000: When Jesus asks you to bless the people, He will supply what's needed.

By faith, God's people continue to serve as their Master did before them. Having nothing of His own (even the foxes and the birds were better off), He constantly ministered to those around Him.

And that's the difference between those who have faith, and those who do not. Which, of course, takes us right back to the issue that started the whole controversy, when Lucifer decided he couldn't trust God to take care of him.

What Lucifer decided not to do, God's people have finally learned how to do! It'll be a happy day in heaven when they see some progress on the "every earthly support" issue—

This "storm and tempest" helps make the final demonstration of the characters of both those who have chosen to serve Satan and those who have chosen to serve Christ.

But if it just takes a sufficiently messed up world to bring on the end of the great controversy, why is it taking so long?

Actually, a messed up world is the least of the delays. The problem with letting go of the four winds too soon, is that God might end up with only one demonstration—the bad one.

Before we move on, let's take a look at what we might reasonably expect to face in the time of the omega. How can we know? By looking at the methods Satan has used in the last two such cases, and remembering that he has nothing new now.



No surprise here. The devil has always tried to prevent the combined ministry that is the only means of properly representing the character of God. And, as in Kellogg's day, one of the primary means is...

Science is good, of course, until it comes into conflict with Inspiration. In other words, whenever there is a conflict between the scientific views of the day and what God says, we have the opportunity to see which we believe.

Of course, there are multiple dangers here. Some people have let misunderstandings of the Bible and Spirit of Prophecy create false conflicts that didn't really exist. The moral of the story is that there is no substitute for getting things right. Fortunately, God has promised to lead His people into all truth.



People making fun of stuff they don't like is not hard to imagine. If you haven't encountered it, I presume you've been in a coma since birth. But ubiquity does not equate to inconsequence! Mockery, even subtle mockery, is deadly!

Selfishness isn't always glaring, not always immediately apparent. It is, however, "at the foundation of all sin."

You may wonder about specifying "church officials." After all, the omega is patterned after the alpha, and the problem in the alpha was the medical guys, wasn't it?

Maybe. Depending on how tightly you constrain your definition. But the truth of the history is that the issue of selfishness began in the publishing office, then spread to the General Conference, and then blossomed out in the Sanitarium. Remember, there were two fires in 1902. About fifty days before the second of those, Ellen White wrote:

"Not all, but many of those who claim to be children of God have become so self-centered, so selfish, so full of idolatry of self, that they are jealous, mistrustful of everyone whom they have an idea will, as they suppose, outshine them; therefore there is strife and bitterness, evil thinking and evil speaking, emulation and hatred.... This is the reason that the Lord cannot endure the sentiments that are being brought into the life and character of the responsible men in the Review and Herald Office."

Well, no surprise that selfishness should affect spending. And remember, it isn't always spending on oneself in an obvious sort of way. Kellogg was generous in his private life, but incredibly selfish in his professional life. Money may not be going to "me," so much as to "my legacy."

Closely related to the spending of money, is the spending of others' labor on the projects of my own choosing.

A couple hundred years ago there was a famous military theorist by the name of Carl von Clausewitz. Apparently he's the source of the saying that "War is the continuation of politics by other means."

Well, a step or two short of that, we might say something like "litigation is the continuation of strategy by other means."

Of course, the Bible puts it a different way. In 1 Corinthians 6, Paul says, "it is already an utter failure for you that you go to law against one another."

The next item on the list is really just an effort to indicate a progression, a worsening of spiritual condition for anyone who follows this path. A while back they were "selfish church officials," but the tendency is for them to move on to...

If that was allowed in heaven, there's a good chance we'll see a parallel in the last days.

This is different from mistakes, or even individuals mingling their own selfish interests with the Lord's work. This is now secretive and intentionally harmful.

The point of being secretive, obviously, is to keep people in the dark. Sadly, many people have lived in that condition for years, so, no surprise, there will be...

Of course, some people will be calling out the plots and conspiracies. Some of that will be good... and much of it will be serving the devil, because the **only** effective response to evil is the way Jesus responded—by revealing the character of God.

Please don't read too much rigidity into the exact order and placement of all these items. It's likely that the sequence will vary from place to place and from one person's experience to another's. I put these near the end, partly because they are among the more seriously significant, but don't think that means they are all off in the future somewhere. This is perhaps the most challenging of all these entries—at least to my mind. All this means, really, is that our test will be on what we, ourselves, really know about the difference between the government of heaven and the principles of Satan's rebellion.

The climax of rebellion always comes with the rejection of God's authority. In Lucifer's case, it was his public assertion that he would could not bear to have Christ reign over him.

With Judas it was finally seen in his betrayal of Christ. And as we've seen, in Kellogg's day it was the direct attack on the credibility of the Spirit of Prophecy.

In regard to final events, we've been told that "The very last deception of Satan will be to make of none effect the testimony of the Spirit of God." That's a terrible thing, but it is the source—at last—of full and final clarity. Sadly, those who have drifted the wrong way will still be blind to even this.
