"Epic Splits" result in Cognitive Dissonance



This stress and discomfort may also arise within an individual who holds a belief and performs a contradictory action or reaction."





Responses to Cognitive Dissonance


The existence of dissonance, being psychologically uncomfortable, will motivate the person to try to reduce the dissonance and achieve consonance.


Responses to Cognitive Dissonance

When dissonance is present, in addition to trying to reduce it, the person will actively avoid situations and information which would likely increase the dissonance






