"Behaved Wisely...?"

The Hebrew word, Sakal, is quite interesting and is translated as "considers." One Hebrew lexicon defines Sakal as "to look at; to look at with the mind; to consider; to attend to." As Hebrew is a picturesque language, the word runs the gamut of possible definitions. It begins with looking at something, then mentally investigating it, and finally, all the way to attending to it. It is a word, then, that encompasses a process.
