# Basic methods of propagation:

seeding and cloning: cuttings, divisions, layering, grafting.



# Cloning: Asexual reproduction

i.e. same genetic makeup as the parent plant



## This can be done by...

- Cuttings- short tips or side shoots.
- Divisions- dividing a clumping plant.
- Layering- rooting a shoot before cutting it off the parent plant.
- Grafting...


### Divisions...

Examples are: Hosta, Grasses, Raspberry, Ginger, Tumeric, Daylily.




## Layering...

### Herbaceous. (annuals, perennials)

<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" – 2" long, new growth, large first shoots of spring are the best.

Notice the fresh new growth



## Examples:

 Basil, Catnip, Chamomile, Fuchia, Lavender, Lemon Balm, Lemon Verbena, Marjoram, Mint, Oregano, Rosemary, Sage, Winter savory, Stevia, French Tarragon, Thyme, Ornamental Potato Vine, Lots of perennials... (Roses, Hibiscus...)



# Geraniums and other thick stemmed plants Use a knife to cut stem to avoid damage...



### **Woody Perennials**

2" -4"long, Cut 1/4" - 1/2" onto the brown woody growth and scarify.


# Examples of woody perennials

## Rooting media

Finer texture soil for seedlings and plug trays: often sold as "plug mix"




Down to 3 -5 seconds on at a time and as often as 20 – 30 minuet intervals
