- Planting
- Harvesting
- Variety


- * Planting
 - ✤ 128 trays
 - ✤ 2-3 weeks before can plant out.
 - Early plantings
 - Direct Seed
 - Spacing
 - * 6"
 - ✤ Weed Control
 - Support?
 - Succession
 - ✤ 1-2 weeks
 - How many?- account for loss



- Harvesting
 - Just as petals are lifting
 - Strip leaves
 - Sickle
 - Rubber Band
 - ✤ 5-10 per bunch
 - 5 Gallon buckets
 - CVBN tablet
 - Store in cooler




- Variety
 - Pollenless
 - Single Stem
 - Pro Cut
 - White
- sunflowerselections.com
- Johnny's Selected Seeds
- Geoseed




- Wholesale Pricing
 - ✤ Mini (center ~1")
 - ***** \$1-\$1.50
 - ✤ Small (center ~1.5-2")
 - ***** \$1.50-\$2
 - * Large
 - ***** \$2-\$3
 - Novelty colors
 - * Add \$0.25-\$0.50
- Farmer's Market/Bouquets



- Planting
 - Start in trays 4-6 weeks before planting out.
 (Frost date)
 - Direct Seed
 - * Spacing: 6-12"
 - Weed control
 - Landscape fabric
 - Support
 - Pinching
 - Successions
 - Different colors



- * Harvesting
 - Zinnias
 - Wiggle test, stiff necks
 - Marigolds
 - Anytime, can also work for foliage
 - Basil
 - When stems are woody
 - Cosmos
 - Tight buds, foliage
 - Clean water, CVBN tablet
 - Sickle and cut deep (pinch)

 - Zinnias
 - Oklahoma Series
 - Benary's Giant Series
 - Queen Series
 - * Floret, Dawn Creek, etc
 - Marigolds
 - Gold and Orange
 - Basil
 - Lemon
 - Cinnamon
 - Thai Towers
 - Cosmos
- ✤ Johnny's and Geoseed



- Wholesale Pricing
 - Zinnias and Marigolds
 - \$9/bunch (10 stems)
 - Basil
 - \$8/bunch
 - Cosmos
 - \$8/bunch




Celosia

- Planting
 - Like warm soil.
 - Plant out when small or direct seed.
 - Don't need a lot of water.
- Harvesting
 - Will continue to grow but will start to drop seeds.

 - Comb- Chief Series
 - Jura Salmon
 - ✤ Plume
 - Texas Plume
 - Pampas
 - Sunday
 - ✤ Wheat
 - * Gardener's Workshop, Johnny's, Geoseed, Floret
- * Wholesale Pricing
 - * Comb- \$1.20/stem
 - Plume- \$1/stem



Hardy Annuals

- Start in fall or early spring
- Snapdragons, Larkspur,
 Poppies, Dianthus, Bupleurum,
 Lisianthus and lots more!
