








The Courtyard


- Revelation 11:1, 2
- God's true worshipers are in the temple
- Measure not the courtyard
- Times of the Gentiles (see also Luke 21:24)
- Holy City is Jerusalem and represents God's people who are persecuted for 1260 years
- Gentiles = papacy





The Two Witnesses

- Revelation 11:3
- A witness gives testimony, or testifies
- John 5:39 Search the Scriptures ... these are they which testify of Me
- Two witnesses are the Old and New Testament of Scripture
- Clothed in Sackcloth for 1260 years
- Scripture suppressed for 1260 years by the papacy in favor of the traditions of the church



Olive Trees and Candlesticks

- Revelation 11:4
- Zechariah 4:1-6: This is the word of the Lord
- Olive tree produces oil
- Candlesticks need oil to produce light
- The Word guides us to the Spirit of Truth, but the Holy Spirit also guides us to the Truth of the Word



Fire From Heaven Water to Blood

- Revelation 11:5, 6
- Fire proceeds out of their mouth and devours their enemies (see 2 Kings 1:9-16 and story of Elijah and King Ahaziah)
- Power to shut heaven that it rain not in the days of their prophecy (1 Kings 18 -**Elijah and King Ahab)**
- Power over waters to turn them to blood and smite the earth with plagues (Moses)





Beast From The Abyss

- Revelation 11:7
- "When they shall have finished their testimony"
- What would you expect to happen when Scripture is suppressed for 1260 years?
- Beast from the abyss ascends
- Satanic power that arises near the end of the 1260 years
- Makes war with Scripture





The French Revolution Sodom and Egypt - Rev. 11:8

- Licentiousness of Sodom
- Story of Lot, his daughters, and the men struck with blindness by the angels
- Origin of the term sodomy
- Atheism of Egypt
- "Who is Jehovah, that I should hearken unto His voice to let Israel go? I know not Jehovah, and moreover I will not let Israel go." Exodus 5:2. GC 269









Origin of The French Revolution

- What led to the anarchy of the French Revolution?
- France was the eldest daughter of the papacy
- Clovis of the Franks used his army to establish the dominance of the papacy in western Europe in 508 AD (arms shall stand on his part -Daniel 11:31)





Religious and Political Abuse in France

- Leading voice in support of the papacy during the 1260 years (eldest daughter of the papacy)
- The Scripture (the two witnesses) was clothed in sackcloth for 1260 years (Rev. 11:2, 3)
- Protestants such as the Huguenots were driven out
- St. Bartholomew's massacre (1572)





Religious and Political Abuse in France

- Three political classes in society
- 1. The clergy (First Estate)
- 2. The nobility (Second Estate)
- 3. The bourgeoisie (Third Estate)
- The King had sovereignty over all classes
- The Third Estate had the majority of people but a minority vote in parliament

1st estate: The Clergy People who worked in the Church

2nd estate: The Nobility

The king and queen, nobles of the sword: princess of royal blood, dukes, marquises, counts, viscounts, barons, knights, and nobles of the robe

3rd estate: Everyone Else

Includes lawyers, doctors, businessmen, merchants, soldiers, craftsmen, shopkeepers, peasants



Oppressed and Oppressors

- The first and second estate lived luxuriously and lived off the labor of the third estate
- The clergy (papacy) and the nobility oppressed the working class
- This unfair system of oppression created a powder keg that exploded in revolution

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At the opening of the Revolution, by a concession of the king, the people were granted a representation exceeding that of the nobles and the clergy combined. Thus the balance of power was in their hands; but they were not prepared to use it with wisdom and moderation. Eager to redress the wrongs they had suffered, they determined to undertake the reconstruction of society. An outraged populace, whose minds were filled with bitter and long-treasured memories of wrong, resolved to revolutionize the state of misery that had grown unbearable and to avenge themselves upon those whom they regarded as the authors of their sufferings. The oppressed wrought out the lesson they had learned under tyranny and became the oppressors of those who had oppressed them. **– GC 282.1**





Unhappy France reaped in blood the harvest she had sown. Terrible were the results of her submission to the controlling power of Rome. Where France, under the influence of Romanism, had set up the first stake at the opening of the Reformation, there the Revolution set up its first guillotine. On the very spot where the first martyrs to the Protestant faith were burned in the sixteenth century, the first victims were guillotined in the eighteenth. In repelling the gospel, which would have brought her healing, France had opened the door to infidelity and ruin. When the restraints of God's law were cast aside, it was found that the laws of man were inadequate to hold in check the powerful tides of human passion; and the nation swept on to revolt and anarchy. **– GC 282.2**










Political Aspect of the French Revolution

- Storming of the Bastille, July 14, 1789
- King Louis XVI executed January 21, 1793
- Around 50,000 died in the reign of terror
- Maximilien Robespierre, one of the lead instigators of the Revolution, was executed July 28, 1794



Religious Aspect of the French Revolution

- Revelation 11:7
- And when they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them.
- Beast = kingdom
- Bottomless pit is from abussos which represents the arsenal of Satan





End-Time Atheism Power of Satan

- Beast = Kingdom
- Beast is from the Abyss
- Satanic Power
- Makes war against the Bible
- Spiritually Sodom and Egypt
- Licentiousness and Atheism
- Revolutionary France was the beginning of this end-time movement





From the Papacy **To Atheism**

- The Scripture was clothed in sackcloth for 1260 years
- The masses viewed the teachings of the church as the teachings of the Scripture and of God
- France declared open war against God and Scripture in the Revolution
- France's view of God had been skewed by the papacy








Satan Has a New Kingdom

- The dragon, Satan, gave his power, seat, and authority to the papacy (Rev. 13:2)
- At the end of the 1260 years, he raises a new satanic power that he controls
- Both are antagonistic to Scripture and persecute God's people

French Revolution Three-and-a-half Years

Revelation 11:9-11


 On June 15, 1797, just over three-and-a-half years later (3 years, 6 months) and 20 odd days), the National Assembly voted that religion be restored and toleration given to the Scriptures, thus fulfilling in remarkable detail





The Deadly Wound **Delivered by France**

- Less than a year after the French **Revolution ended, Napoleon's** general Berthier took Pope Pius VI captive on February 20, 1798
- The deadly wound was inflicted on the papacy as it lost control over the state power
- Thus came to an end the 1260 years of papal supremacy from 538 - 1798 AD.



The Revolution Lives On

- Karl Marx wrote the Communist Manifesto from Paris, France, published in 1848
- Atheism is a foundational principle to his teachings
- He teaches that class distinction leads to oppression
- In the cultural variation, modern Marxism teaches that religious and ethnic privilege can also lead to oppression





The Revolution Lives On

- The Communist Manifesto gave rise to the Russian Revolution of 1917
- Vladimir Lenin was the revolutionary of his time
- Communism works to destroy class distinction and place everyone on equal footing (with the exception of the party leaders)

At the end of 3 and 1/2 years, Christ died on the cross (deadly wound)

 Papacy receives power from Satan, reigns for 3 and 1/2 prophetic years (538 - 1798) and then receives deadly wound. Resurrection is future (NSL)





Principles Behind the Revolution

- At the end of the 3 and 1/2 prophetic years (1260 years from 538 -1798) of papal supremacy, there are 3 and 1/2 literal years of the **French Revolution**



Secularism and Spiritualism

- Secularism is a form of spiritualism that is satanic at its root
- above a plain "Thus saith the Lord"

 It paves the way for secularists/atheists to believe the supernatural manifestations of spiritualism in the last days when fire comes down from heaven on the earth in the sight of men (Rev. 13:13, 14)

 The satanic supernatural manifestations that occur in the last days will be readily accepted by those who have never lived by faith in God's word and who place human experience and philosophy

 While the Sunday law will come from the religious right, progressive secularism is also preparing people to receive the mark of the beast due to its rejection of the plain teachings of God's Word





Jesus is the Truth

- John 14:6 I am the way, the truth, and the life.
- Now is not the time to be joining forces with secular ideology
- Truth is not relative
- Every truth in Scripture is connected to Jesus, Who is the Truth
- Seventh-day Adventists should not be activists for any political ideology, including secular, progressive philosophy
- Secular philosophy is antithetical to truth and to Christ
- As Seventh-day Adventists, we are to follow Christ and His truth for the last days

Adventism vs. the French Revolution

- The rise of the Second Advent Movement is described in Revelation 10
- The French Revolution is seen in Revelation 11:1-14
- The conclusion of the sixth trumpet is seen at the end of Revelation 9, but also through Revelation 11:1-14
- The seventh trumpet sounds in Revelation 11:15-19
- The first four trumpets are a judgment on the Western Roman Empire
- The 5th and 6th trumpets are judgments on the Eastern Roman Empire
- The 7th trumpet is a judgment on the Papal Roman Empire and ultimately culminates in the seven last plagues





Adventism vs. the French Revolution

- The French Revolution occurs at the end of the 1260 years
- The principles of anti-Christ are fully seen
- God is vindicated to begin the judgment in heaven
- Rev. 11:15 the kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord and of His Christ; and He shall reign for ever and ever
- Why is the Second Advent Movement seen between the sounding of the sixth and seventh trumpets?
- When the mystery of God is finished, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory (Col. 1:27), God will be vindicated to finish the judgment, cleanse the sanctuary and come back as king of kings and Lord of Lords!
